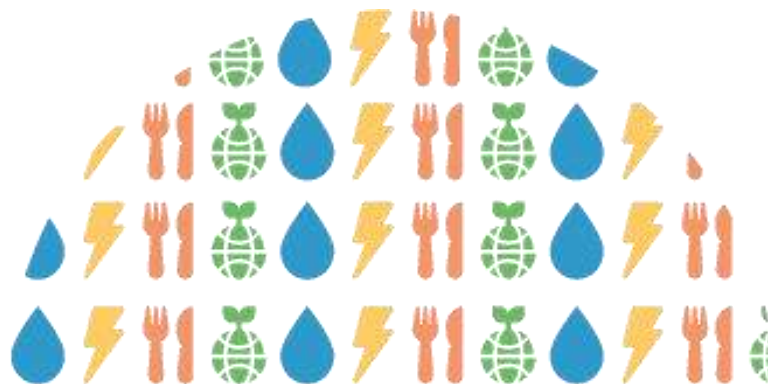

Intégration du Genre dans BONEX

Comité du genre: représentants des partenaires en tenant compte de la dimension de genre lors de l'analyse des relations sociales, des rôles et des normes (55,2 % de femmes)

- ✓ Femmes représentées dans les équipes de prise de décision de BONEX : 1 coordinatrice, 3/5 groupes de tâches dirigés par des femmes.
- ✓ 50 % de l'équipe du conseil consultatif.
- ✓ 50 % de l'équipe de coordination du projet.
- ✓ Équipes du projet : 43,5% (recherche et l'innovation et gestion de l'exploitation et les activités de diffusion).



Women play a crucial role in global sustainable agriculture and climate action, representing approximately half of the agricultural workforce in developing nations and leading the majority of smallholder farming operations.

Their contributions span agricultural production, food security, biodiversity conservation, and climate-resilient farming practices.

Women are at the forefront of innovation, entrepreneurship, and leadership in agriculture, advocating for gender-responsive policies and driving positive change.

Investing in women's education and access to resources enhances their resilience and empowerment, paving the way for more inclusive and equitable agricultural systems.

Efforts to address gender disparities are gaining momentum, highlighting the importance of empowering women for a resilient future.

1 What is the Gender Perspective?

BONEX prioritizes gender equity by advocating for gender-sensitive policies, addressing disparities in agriculture and food processing, and ensuring women's active participation in decision-making bodies and stakeholder groups.

This commitment is evident in the project's demonstration projects, which integrate women's perspectives to tackle gender-related challenges.

Gender mainstreaming is central to BONEX's approach, fostering inclusivity and interdisciplinary collaboration.

Aligned with the Union for Mediterranean Water Agenda and Responsible Research and Innovation principles, BONEX emphasizes gender equality, transboundary cooperation, and stakeholders engagement.

2 How does it work?

Specific tasks focus on examining the impact of interventions on gender and minorities, challenging stereotypes, and promoting women's involvement in various project activities.

A Gender Committee oversees gender dimensions in project activities, aiming for gender balance and documenting gender actions through a Gender Action Report.

3 What will happen?

Targeted groups, including Local DP Steering Groups, Regional Working Groups (RWGs), and the BONEX Community of Practice, engage in communication, dissemination, and exploitation efforts.

Special attention is given to involving and representing women in surveys and events, recognizing their vulnerability to unbalanced WFP practices.
